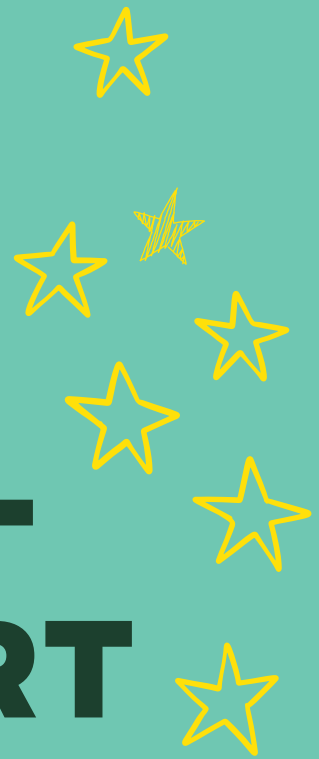

Children of Incarcerated Parents Partnership (COIPP) had much to celebrate in 2025. We continued our monthly children's activities that allowed families time for fun, as well as the opportunity to meet with others in similar circumstances. We had Sharing Fairs at the Frederick County Adult Detention Center (FCADC) where we distributed books, hygiene products, coats, shoes, and more to those visiting their loved ones. Our Respite groups met monthly to discuss topics of interest, including nutrition, discipline, children's resources and more. One of our most exciting opportunities has been our return to teaching Parenting From Afar at FCADC! We also provided case management to our participants in greatest need.

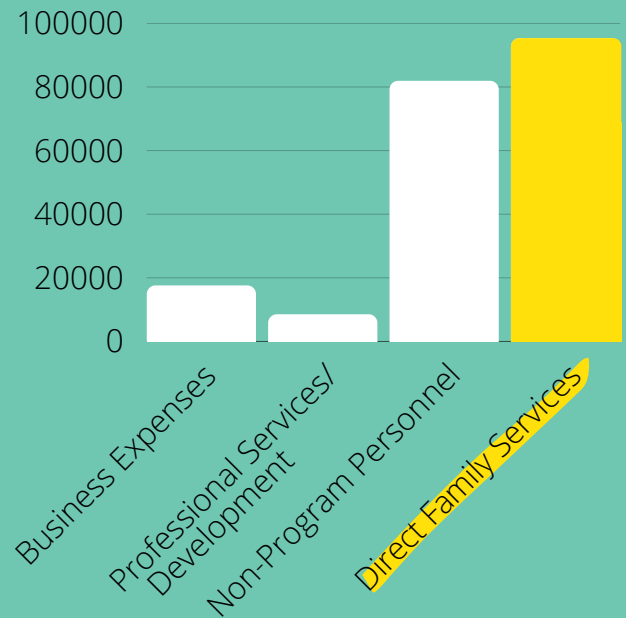
